NOTIFICATION

All Ph.D. supervisors and Ph.D. students of the university are hereby informed that only research publications in the list of research journals recognized by the university shall be considered against the minimum requirement of two publications for Ph.D. scholars registered before 7-10-2009 and in one refereed journal for those who registered after 7-10-2009. From 1st July 2011, all Ph.D. supervisors are requested to forward only those Ph.D. thesis having research papers published/accepted in the following category of journals satisfying the approval process. The research work published must be a part of research work included in the thesis.

Category of journals	Explanation/Approval process
International Journals	Refereed foreign journals published by reputed International Publishers & indexed in International subject databases/ Abstracting journals.
National Journals	Refereed journals in the list approved by the Co-ordination Committee (as per list available in the department/University website) OR Reputed ISSN journals in the subject concerned approved by a committee as per UGC regulation (under preparation). However, non-refereed journals shall not be considered for those who have registered after 7-9-2009 The list of approved ISSN journals will be made available after approval of the committee consisting of Faculty chairman, Subject expert

	and Library expert. Till then approval of the PGRB will be required.
Indian Language Journals (only for Sanskrit/Hindi/ Prakrit & Jainology)	Approved by PGRB or Coordination Committee
Any other journals	Individual cases must be submitted for the approval of the PGRB.

Note: Ph.D. scholars who have registered before 7-9-2009 and intend to publish research papers in National Journals/Indian Language journals which are not approved by coordination committee/ISSN journal approval committee should apply on a prescribed proforma for consideration of PGRB. A copy of the latest issue of the journal or details of the journal from its website must be submitted to the PGRB to determine the reputation, refereeing policy, frequency of publication, Editorial board, publishers etc.

Ph.D. scholars are advised to publish their work in reputed refereed national/International subject journals since the standard of the Ph.D. work of a scholar is normally judged from the quality of publications that have resulted from it.
