

GUIDELINES FOR EXAMINATION OF Ph.D. COURSE WORK

1. The Ph.D. course work consists two papers as follows

	Lectures*	Assignments /Workshops	Total
a. Paper-I : ICT & Research Methodology	80 hrs	40hrs	120 hrs
b. Paper-II: Review of Literature/Research Techniques			250 hrs

2. The course work for Paper-I is conducted faculty wise in the university level as per prescribed syllabus where as the course work for paper-II will be conducted at the department level. The Department committee will design the topics on which the reviews to be carried out by the candidate and research techniques on which the candidate to be trained. Paper-II can be carried out on self study basis by assigning library work, assignments etc.by the supervisors.
3. During the course work the student is required to prepare a review report as per format approved by the department and submit the same to the Dean, PG studies through Supervisor and Head of the Department at the end of the semester.
4. A candidate is expected to work at least 250 hrs in a semester for paper-II
5. Examination on paper-I will consist One theory paper of 100 marks, 3hrs duration and Practical paper of 100 marks, 6 hrs duration.
6. Examination on paper-II will consist of evaluation of Review report by an external examiner . External examiner will assess the review and award marks out of 100. A Viva Voce examination will also be conducted by the PG Research Board and award marks out of 50.
7. A candidate will be required to present his or her review report using Power point presentation in the PGRB.
8. A candidate will be required to obtain at least 50% marks in each paper for satisfactory completion of the course work.
9. If a candidate fails to get minimum 50% marks in each paper, he/she shall be required to repeat the paper as and when the same is offered again
10. No re-evaluation is allowed in the Ph.D. course work examination
11. Minimum of 75% attendance in the course work is mandatory to attend the course work examination
