The University promotes an environment for innovations and for the creation and transfer of knowledge for the benefit of society.

- Research environment and infrastructure: The University has ultra-modern research infrastructural facilities at par with many national organizations. Many departments are equipped with hi-tech instruments which help to improve the level of research. State-of-the-art facilities like Central Library, Central Instrumental Laboratories (in different departments), Geological Museum, Drug Museum, Animal House, etc., add extra assistance for research and innovation. The University e-library has also subscribed to over 8000 online journals and 200 e-books, and facilitated with OPAC. The University is accessible on maximum portals of academic importance, and as an active member of INFLIBNET and DELNET, numerous resources for information are available to cater to the needs of scholars and researchers.
- Creation and dissemination of knowledge: The University strongly believes in creation and transfer of knowledge across various platforms. Seminars, conferences, workshops and training programmes are conducted regularly by the departments for skill development, Intellectual Property Rights, plagiarism, qualitative research etc. Different events on statistical software's (SPSS), reference management software (Mendeley) and Latex has been organized for enhancing subject-specific knowledge of staff and students. The Department of Geography has conducted National Level Winter School on Geospatial Technologies under the aegis of Natural Resources Data Management System (NRDMS), Department of Science and Technology (DST), Government of India, New Delhi, for providing training to government professionals and faculty of higher education institutions in the field of geospatial technology.

# "होली: जीवंत भारतीय मूल्यों और संस्कृति का संरक्षक " पर सुविवि के इतिहास विभाग द्वारा दो दिवसीय अंतर्राष्ट्रीय वेबिनार का आयोजन

इतिहास विभाग मोहनलाल सुखाड़िया विश्वविद्यालय उदयपुर और इंडस इंटरनेशनल रिसर्च फाउंडेशन, नई दिल्ली के संयुक्त तत्वावधान में दो दिवसीय अंतर्राष्ट्रीय वेबिनार का आयोजन 11 और 12 जून, 2021 को किया गया। जिसका विषय "होली: जीवंत भारतीय मूल्यों और संस्कृति का संरक्षक" है। वेबिनार के आयोजन सचिव सुविवि के इतिहास विभाग के सहायक आचार्य डाॅ. पीयूष भादिवया है। आयोजन सचिव डाॅ. पीयूष भादिवया ने बताया कि 11 जून को उद्घाटन सत्र का आयोजन हुआ जिसमें कुल 55 शोध-पत्र तथा लगभग 300 प्रतिभागियों ने भाग लिया। देष के 18 राज्यों एवं 8 विभिन्न देषों से विद्वान वेबिनार के माध्यम से जुड़े। सर्वप्रथम वेबिनार के मुख्य संरक्षक प्रो. अमेरिका सिंह कुलपित सुविवि ने मूल कर्तव्य पढ़ के सुनाया। ई-स्मारिका का विमोचन किया गया। विभागाध्यक्ष प्रो. दिग्वजय भटनागर ने सभी का स्वागतज्ञापित किया।

सत्र की मुख्य अतिथि डाॅ. किरण सोनी गुप्ता आईएएस, निर्देशक पश्चिमी क्षेत्र सांस्कृतिक केन्द्र रही। डाॅ. गुप्ता ने बताया संस्कृति देश के सॉफ्टवेयर की तरह होती है। किसी भी देश की उपलब्धि उनकी कला एवं संस्कृति से होती हैं। यह परंपरा हड़प्पा सभ्यता से ही जारी है। उन्होंने बताया कि भारतीय कला वर्ग में राजा रिव वर्मा, अमृता शेरगिल, नंदलाल बोस, रिवंद्रनाथ टैगोर आदि ने यूरोपीय प्रभुत्व को तोड़ा है। इस प्रकार होली एवं अन्य पर्व उत्पाद के साथ-साथ पर्यटन को बढ़ावा देते हैं। उन्होंने कला संस्कृति के संरक्षण पर जोर की बात कही तथा अपने अनुभव साझा किये। प्रो. सीमा मिलक अधिष्ठाता कला महाविद्यालय ने अध्यक्षता करते हुए बताया कि होली पर्व एकता का परिचायक है, जो सभी भेदभाव को दूर करता है। उन्होंने पंजाब की होली जिसे होला मोहल्ला कहा जाता है जो युद्ध अध्ययन एवं युद्धाभ्यास की जानकारी देता है।

विशिष्ट वक्ता के रूप में डॉ. श्री कृष्ण 'जुगन्' भारत के प्रख्यात इतिहासकार अर्थवन परिषष्ट में भारतीय उत्सवों का पहला लेखा मिलता है जिसमें होलाक्ष शब्द जो फसल से संबंधित है। यह परंपरा संपूर्ण भारतीय उपमहाद्वीप में प्रचलित है। माघ शुक्ल पंचमी से चैत्र शुक्ल पंचमी तक अर्थात् दो माह यह पर्व चलता है। जिसका अंत गणगौर विसर्जन के साथ होता है, फिर राखी बड़ा उत्सव आता है। यह त्यौहार जीवन में परंपराएं, उल्लास और शोकनिवृत्ति का बोधक है। मेवाड़ में महाराणा प्रताप की काल में लिखी पुस्तक 'व्यवहार आदर्श' में भी होली पर्व और व्यवहार का वर्णन है। अभिनव पुराण होली के प्रसंगों को बताता है। तीन अवसर पर रंग की बात आती है विवाह, बसंत और विजय का उत्सव। यह पूर्णतया असहिष्ण् है।

प्रो. हेराम्ब चतुर्वेदी डीन कला संकाय इलाहाबाद विश्वविद्यालय ने बृज की होली से अपनी बात प्रारंभ करते हुए, होलिका दहन के स्वरूप प्रकृति को समझाया। उन्होंने बताया कि होलिका दहन काम के दहन से जुड़ा है। होलाष्टक से राधा अष्टमी तक की पुरी परम्परा है। महादेवजी का जन्म होली पर हुआ। राधा-कृष्ण से संबंधित रंग की कहानी स्पष्ट कही। होली को श्रीमद्भागवत पुराण का संजीव चित्रण किया। अंत में बृज का परम्परागत गीत सुनाया।

भूविज्ञानी एवं भू-वैज्ञानिक प्रोफेसर पुष्पेंद्र सिंह राणावत ने होली के वैज्ञानिक एवं प्राकृतिक आधार पर प्रकाश डाला। उन्होंने कहा कि शरद ऋतु के बाद पेड़ों की पत्तियां सुखती हैं और उनको इकट्ठा कर जलाया जाता है। होलाष्टक पर बहुत सारे कार्य निषेध हो जाते हैं। महाराणा प्रताप का राज्याभिषेक का पहला आदेश होली से संबंधित था। उन्होंने मेवाड के सिटी पैलेस की परम्परागत होली की सम्पूर्ण जानकारी दी और बताया कि पहले दिन होलिका दहन, दूसरे दिन रंग होली, तीसरे दिन हाडा होली जिसमें महाराणा मिलने वाले आगंतुकों को 'वसंत खड़ा' एक प्रकार की तलवार के साथ में लाल, नीला, हरा फुल एवं नारियल भेंट किया जाता था। नये जन्मे बच्चे को होलिका दहन के समय राणा के साथ परिचय कराया जाता था। प्रवेश सावन प्रशिक्षण समन्वयक मॉरीशस प्रशिक्षण एवं विकास संस्थान गणराज्य मॉरीशस ने मॉरीशस की होली के बारे में विस्तारपूर्वक बताया। अंत में पूर्वविभागाध्यक्ष प्रो. प्रतिभा ने सभी का धन्यवाद ज्ञापित किया।

#### विश्व मानसिक स्वास्थ्य दिवस और अंतराष्ट्रीय बालिका दिवस

यू. जी. सी. महिला अध्ययन केंद्र एवं चीफ़ वॉर्डन ऑफ़िस, यूनिवर्सिटी हास्टल्ज़, मोहनलाल सुखाडिया विश्वविद्यालय के तत्वावधान में विश्व मानसिक स्वास्थ्य दिवस (१० अक्टूबर २०२१) और अंतराष्ट्रीय बालिका दिवस (११ अक्टूबर २०२१) के उपलक्ष्य पर मानसिक स्वास्थ्य विषय के प्रति जागरूकता बढ़ाने के लिए १० अक्टूबर को एम डी एस गर्ल्ज़ हॉस्टल में मानसिक स्वास्थ्य पर एक व्याख्यान का आयोजन किया गया और १० अक्टूबर से १७ अक्टूबर तक एक सप्ताह का योग शिविर का आयोजन किया गया। डॉक्टर गरिमा मिश्रा, सहायक आचार्य, यू जी सी महिला अध्ययन केंद्र एवं वॉर्डन, एम डी एस गर्ल्ज़ हॉस्टल ने कुलपित प्रो. अमेरिका सिंह को विभाग की तरफ़ से धन्यवाद देते हुए केंद्र निवेशक प्रो प्रतिभा एवं चीफ़ वॉर्डन प्रो मंजुबागमार का संदेश छात्राओं तक पहुँचाया। बालिका शिक्षा के महत्व और पूर्व गर्भाधान और प्रसव पूर्व निदान तकनीक (PCPNDT) अधिनियम, 1994 के विषय पर छात्राओं को जागरूक किया।

मानसिक स्वास्थ्य पर चर्चा करते हुए डॉक्टर हेमा मेहर, सहायक आचार्य, मनोविज्ञान विभाग ने छात्राओं से बातचीत की और उन्हें शारीरिक स्वास्थ्य के साथ मानसिक स्वास्थ्य को बेहतर रखने के उपाय साझा किए। और यह भी बताया की छात्राएँ कैसे समझे कि वे किसी मानसिक समस्या से गुज़र रही है।

योग एक्स्पर्ट श्रीमती मीना जैन छात्राओं को एक सप्ताह के योग शिविर में सुबह एक घंटा योग के गुर सिखाने के साथ इनसे होने वाले लाभ की जानकारी भी दी। यह सात दिवसीय शिविर में ३० से अधिक छात्राओं को लाभ प्राप्त हुआ । इस शिविर में योग एक्स्पर्ट मीना जैन द्वारा प्रत्येक दिन विभिन्न योग आसन और प्राणायाम छात्राओं को सिखाया गया। जिसमें क्रमशः शरीर को मजबूत करने, लचक बढ़ाने, ब्लड सर्क्यलेशन बेहतर करने, मोटापा कम लेने, माहवारी की समस्या, मानसिक स्वास्थ्य को बेहतर बनाने के लिए उपयोगी व् उचित योगासन व प्राणायाम बताए गए तथा आख़िरी दिन छात्राओं ने अपनी समस्याओं को एक्सपर्ट के साथ साझा किया और योगा की टेक्नीक से सम्बंधित प्रश्नोत्तर किए। छात्राओं ने इन सात दिनों के अपने अनुभव साझा किए और आग्रह किया कि योगा शिविर लम्बे समय के लिए आयोजित किए जाए जिससे वे इसे बेहतर तरीक़े से सीख सकें।

डॉ गरिमा मिश्रा और मीना जैन ने छात्राओं के सभी सवालों का जवाब दिया और कार्यक्रम का समापन ध्यान की क्रिया के साथ किया गया। इस मौके पर डॉ मिश्र ने कुलपित अमरीका सिंह के मार्गदर्शन एवं प्रोत्साहन के लिए धन्यवाद् ज्ञापित किया। और छात्रावास की वार्डन स्नेहा सिंह, सहायक आचार्य, विधि महाविद्यालय ने श्रीमती मीना जैन को छात्राओं को अपना समय देने के लिए आभार व्यक्त किया और सभी को धन्यवाद दिया।

He told that today we have land available for cultivation, but we are not able to do crop rotation today, due to which the soil does not get time for the rotation of nutrients and to increase production we are using chemical fertilizers in more quantity. Which are proving fatal for us. Villages located around Udaipur city where vegetables are grown from drain water have about 24% zinc which is a heavy element and can cause cancer in future. He said that with the use of vermiculture, we can improve the health of the soil and from that we can move towards good quality organic farming. He said that work is being done on vermicompost in Krishi Vigyan Kendra and Agricultural University, but Zoology Department is the first department of science where work is being done on it by giving so much importance to vermicompost. During the program, Prof. Arti Prasad informed the participants about the career hub and training programs being started very soon by the department and the work being done by the department in the field of computer technology. The copyright law encourages authors, composers and artists to create original works by rewarding them with the exclusive right for a limited period to reproduce the work for the benefit of the public.

But with the advancement of technology the threat to the violation of copyright is also increasing. The easy accessibility of information has made the infringement also easy. Plagiarism which is an act of fraud involves both stealing someone else's work and lying about it afterward. Plagiarism in academic and research institutions is an old but ever growing problem. The exponential growth in scholarly publications makes it harder for faculty and instructor to detect the plagiarized sources. Plagiarism can be a very serious form of ethical misconduct. For this reason, the concept of plagiarism is universally addressed in all scholarly, artistic, and scientific disciplines.
