Sub.: Consideration of approval of B.Pharm course. & examinations.

Sir/Madam

This is a reference to the subject cited above. In this connection I am directed to state that matter regarding approval of your institution was placed in 92nd Central Council of the PCI in its meeting held in March, 2013 which decided as under—

"(1) In pursuance of the provisions of sub section (1) of section 12 of the Pharmacy Act, 1948 (8 of 1948), the Pharmacy Council of India declares the Degree course in Pharmacy conducted by institution mentioned below to be an approved course of study for the purpose of admission to an approved examination for Diploma, Degree and PharmaD (Post Baccalaureate) course in Pharmacy in respect of number of students and academic session as specified here under:

Mohanlal Sukhadia University, New Campus, Udaipur-313 001	- Subject to submission of affiliation fee per annum to the PCI within the stipulated time period. - It was further decided to instruct the institution to submit duly attested affidavit to the effect that - • Institute will restrict admission to sanctioned intake by PCI & will not admit students beyond sanctioned intake without prior approval of the PCI.

Institute will not start additional Pharmacy Programme/start 2nd evening / additional shift in the existing pharmacy institution. Institution shall comply with statutory norms and standards prescribed by the PCI from time to time. The entire consequences of failure to comply with the undertaking shall rest on the institution and PCI in no way shall be responsible for the same.

2) In pursuance of the provisions of sub-section (2) of section 12 of the Pharmacy Act, 1948 (8 of 1948),—the Pharmacy Council of India declares the Degree Examination in Pharmacy held by the above mentioned Examining Authority, during the session mentioned above to be an approved examination for the purpose of qualifying for registration as a Pharmacist under the said Act."
