
- Where structuralism was connected with the structure(parts of consciousness) of the mind
- Functionalism was concerned with how our mind works or functions




 Functionalism refers to a school of thought within psychology that examines mental processes and how they relate to human behavior. **Functionalism** originated in the United States in the late nineteenth century





 Functionalism values empirical thought and practical research, rather than the theoretical science of structuralism.




 Psychologists William James and philosopher John **Dewey** represent famous advocates of functionalism. William James published "Principles of Psychology" in 1890.








 William James borrowed the concept from Darwinism of nativism. He believed in nature as the cause of behaviors which influence the brain to cause different types of disorders if damaged. The weakness of functionalism influenced the rise of behaviorism in early 20th century.



 James contributed to functionalism theory as argued that all behavioral origins begins within the nervous system prompting all scientists of human behavior to possess basic physiological, understanding, something very well understood by the functionalist founder **James**



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
