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MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE FACULTY OF SCIENCE HELD ON 20-08-2018

A meeting of the Faculty of Science was held on 20-08-2018 at 3.00 PM in the chamber of the Dean, University College of Science. Following members were present in the meeting :-

At the outset Chairman of the Faculty of Science welcome the members of the Faculty of Science and thereafter Faculty of Science considered the following matters and resolved as under :-

1. Considered letter No. DBT/2018/107 received from the Course Director Biotechnology to run Skill Development Certificate/Diploma/PG Diploma Programme from the session 2018-19. The Faculty of Science **Resolved** to approve these Skill Development Courses proposed by Course Director of Biotechnology with the condition that the these Skill Development Courses may be run from the academic session 2019-20.

2. Prof. Kanika Sharma, Head of the Department of Botany & Convener, Committee of Courses in Botany placed revised syllabus of M.Sc. Botany (CBCS) for implementation from the academic session 2019-20. The Faculty of Science **Resolved** to approve the revised syllabus to be run from the academic session 2019-20.

3. Prof. Atul Tyagi, Head, Department of Mathematics & Statistics placed the minutes of the meeting of Departmental Committee and Local Members of Committee of Courses dated 20-8-2018. The Committee unanimously resolved to allow the B.Tech. and permitted to appear as non-collegiate student for P.G. Mathematics along with "Bridge Course Structure for B.Tech. Engineering Graduates who are seeking admission in M.Sc. (Mathematics) Programme under CBCS and Non Collegiate Scheme effective from 2018-19".

Abstract of recommendation of above Committees in Mathematics is as follows:

To provide an opportunity to B.Tech. Graduate students in M.Sc. (Mathematics) Programme, the Committee of Courses recommended that if the candidate passes the additional three papers which are not available in B.Tech. programme, then their eligibility may be considered for admission in M.Sc. (Mathematics) on regular basis/

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non-collegiate basis. B.Tech. students should be permitted to appear in additional three papers and it will be treated as Bridge Course for M.Sc. (Mathematics) Programme. The schedule of examination of this Bridge Course will be same as our UG Programme in B.Sc. Mathematics as being run by M.L. Sukhadia University.

During the admission process for PG Mathematics through entrance examination, the total percentage (according to CGPA/SGPA conversion rules of the concerned university) of theory papers along with the additional three papers will be considered at the time of preparing merit for the admission in PG Course in Mathematics under CBCS scheme and total percentage of B.Tech. course along with the additional three papers will be considered for eligibility to appear in examinations as non-collegiate.

The nomenclature and syllabus of Bridge Course is as follows :

1. **Algebra** (As prescribed for First Year B.Sc. Mathematics 2017-18, Paper-I)
2. **Real Analysis** (As prescribed for Third Year B.Sc. Mathematics 2017-18, Paper-I)
3. **Abstract Algebra** (As prescribed for Third Year B.Sc. Mathematics 2017-18, Paper-II)

Hence, the rules of passing and syllabus will be same which are available for B.Sc. Programme of our university. Maximum time for qualifying of this course (3 papers) is two years. After successful completion of this course, student will be eligible to get admission in M.Sc. Programme on regular as well as eligible to appear in examination of non-collegiate basis."

The Faculty of Science **Resolved to approve the recommendation of the Committee of Courses in Mathematics as proposed in above abstract**, allowing the B.Tech.(Engineering) students for admission in M.Sc. (Mathematics) after completing the Bridge Course.

4. The Faculty of Science considered the letter dated 20-8-2018 received from Prof. Kanika Sharma, Convener, Committee of Courses in Biotechnology & Microbiology and **resolved to Nominate Prof. Rajesh Kumar Dubey**, Course Director, Biotechnology and Microbiology as **Convener, Committee of Courses in Biotechnology & Microbiology** (in place of Prof. Kanika Sharma).
5. Considered the **PEER TEAM REPORT ON Institutional Re-accreditation of Mohanlal Sukhadia University (April 26,2014 for implementation of Recommendations for Quality Enhancement of the University)**. To meet out the suggestion of Peer Team in Section IV : Recommendations for Quality Enhancement of the University which reads as "University may adopt uniform nomenclature consistent with the nomenclature in use in the country for faculty/departments/centres/colleges/schools", the Faculty of Science **Resolved to adopt the name of "School of Pure and Applied Sciences" in place of "University College of Science"**. Other internal set-ups of faculty/departments/units to be kept as such.

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6. Considered the suggestions of amendment in CBCS rules as applicable in PG courses. The Faculty of Science constituted a Committee of the following members to suggest amendments in CBCS rules :
