At the outset the Faculty Chairman, Prof Sanjay Lodha extended a warm welcome to all the members present in the meeting.


Firstly, Director introduced agenda of the meeting for discussion; the following agenda items were discussed and resolved:

Agenda Item 1:	Discussion and approval of syllabus, exam scheme and nomenclature of "Garment Production and Export Management/ "Fashion Technology & Designing" for Undergraduate students.
Resolution:	Unanimously approved nomenclature of "Fashion Technology & Designing" instead of "Garment Production and Export Management" and content of Syllabus with two theory papers and one practical paper for each year of three year Degree course. (Annexure 1) Proposed nomenclature will be effective from academic session 2020-21
Agenda Item 2:	Discussion and approval of syllabus and nomenclature of "Certificate Course on Women and Legal Rights" for Undergraduate students
Resolution:	Unanimously approved proposed nomenclature and content of Syllabus with three modules for certificate course. (Annexure 2)
Agenda Item 3:	Need to start Degree course for Undergraduate students
Resolution:	It was consistent demand from students to start UG level programme for further studies after completing their diploma in relevant field. The curriculum of the course is very relevant in the emerging scenario of Garment and export industry. It also provides ample opportunity for self employment and entrepreneurship. So it was resolved to start degree course in Fashion Technology & Designing.
Agenda Item 4:	Need to start certificate course in "Certificate Course on Women and Legal Rights"
Resolution:	The course is of six months certificate level programme, designed for professionals as well as college students who wish to gain additional knowledge about women and legal rights. It is specific short term course catering the demand of professionals associated with Government and non

government organizations. Further, it was suggested by members that it is also beneficial for regular students as add-on course. Therefore, it was unanimously decided by the members to start this certificate course from 2020-2021 academic sessions for college students and employees along with persons from other professions.


Agenda Item 4: Fee structure of Certificate course on "Women and Legal Rights"

- Course level** : Diploma
- Course title** : Diploma in **Fashion Design & Technology**
- Course duration** : One year full time program
- Strength** : 15
- Reservation of Seats: As per rules of University
- Eligibility** : 12th pass from any discipline (Arts/Science/Commerce)
- Medium of Instructions:** Bilingual (Hindi/ English)
- Course curriculum** : 2 Theory papers + 4 Practical papers
- Total marks** : 600 marks; each theory paper is of 100 marks and Practical paper is of 100 marks
- Admission Process : Based on Merit (As per University rule)
- Faculty : The University should use its regular faculty if existing, additionally; they may recruit or hire faculty on contractual basis and guest faculty as per UGC norms.
