## MASTER OF ARTS IN POLITICAL SCIENCE

- 1. Duration of the Course:** The Master of Arts (Political Science) course will be of four semester and Choice Based Credit System and Ability Enhancement (Skill Based) scheme in Masters Degree duration to be conducted in two years. Each semester will be of approximately five months (minimum 90 working days in a semester) duration.
- 2. Eligibility:** Candidates seeking admission to the first semester of Master of Arts in Political Science must have a B.A. or an equivalent degree with 48% marks. Candidates who have studied Political Science Honors at BA Level will be preferred.

**Paper : (M4POL01-CT- 20) Dissertation based on Project work**

Each student will write a dissertation based on field work on a research question of his/her choice. For this each student will be provided with a Faculty Advisor. The student will be expected to apply relevant research tools in writing the dissertation. The dissertation will carry 100 marks. Of these 20 marks will be for presentation of the dissertation before the Departmental Committee and 80 marks will be for external assessment. In the Departmental Committee meeting the student will be expected to make a power-point presentation.
