

2. Minutes of meetings with mentees

i) For July, 2018 to January, 2019

Over the course of time the following activities were conducted for the students aimed to enhance their academics, communication skills and overall progress. They were encouraged to participate in the activities and feedbacks were taken.

a. Atlas Drill: (5th-15th September, 2018)

One-week sessions on 'World Atlas Drill' using computer-based audio-visual facility in the department was conducted for the students in which geographical information and facts about places using atlas were discussed. Students were asked to bring their atlas daily to the classes and an overview about various places, their locations, physical geography and geographical concepts related with certain regions were discussed in detail on a continent-wise basis. Throughout the sessions students developed a perspective of memorizing the locations of places in context to their general geography.

The feedback by the students was very positive as they got confidence in all their semester papers and understood the subject in its broader perspective. It helped them to improve their geographical knowledge of the world.

Students were excited and suggested to include 'map-activity' in future along with these sessions.

b. Communication Skill Development: (28.09.2018)

A session was organized for the students to present a topic from their syllabus before class to improve their presentation skills and subject conceptualization in a group activity. Students were divided in a group of four and were asked to present different aspects of 'Christaller's Central Place Theory'. The presentations were also followed by query sessions. Students were individually observed and guided to further improve their skills.

Feedbacks were very positive as many students gave their first presentations which gave them lot of confidence.

c. Computer literacy: (5.10.2019)

A demo session was organized where students were taught how to make power point presentations and some do's and don'ts of presentations were told.

d. Interaction with students:

One-on-one interactions with students about their academic problems were made. The mentees have been regularly monitored on their academic progress and counselled on their issues.

ii) For February to April, 2019

Meetings were held on: 19, 22 Feb, 5, 27, 29 March, 2019

Meeting: 19th February, 2019

Agenda: Introductory session, Briefing about the mentor-mentee program

Students were briefed about the mentor-mentee program, its objectives and how they can be benefitted with it. An informal session was conducted with the students to get an insight about their lifestyle, hobbies, tastes and specifically their academic problems.

Feedback:

Most of the students had problem of unavailability of the books.

Meeting: 22nd February 2019

Agenda: Career counselling

A career counselling session was conducted where students were asked to decide their career options and start preparing for it right from the moment. Since most the students showed interest in academic careers, a session on "how to prepare for NET-JRF" was conducted. The students were guided with the question paper pattern of NET-JRF, syllabus and how to integrate their semester studies with this preparation. The significance of in-depth studies was advised. Important books were recommended for competitive exams.

Meeting: 5th March, 2019

Agenda: Self-Discipline, Personal Relations & Personality Development

Students were asked to prepare a daily routine time-table to enhance the quality of self-discipline in their lives. They were asked to allocate most of their time for studies (at least 6 hours daily) while making physical activities, hobbies and newspaper reading a part of their daily routine.

To boost their confidence and to stay self-motivated students were asked to spend more time with their parents and family. They were encouraged to start their day with a routine practice of meditation.

Feedback:

Students followed their time table religiously. They realized that getting organized in life make them more productive. Some of the students also tried to practice meditation and felt really happy and peaceful throughout the day.

Students were asked to write an essay on any topic from the syllabus of their choice in 300 words. They were told about things that makes their writing more impressive.

Report

Mentor - Mentee Program Group- M.A./M.Sc. Semester III (2019-2020) Mentor - Ms. Urmi Sharma (Assistant Professor)

The following report consist of minutes of the meetings conducted for the mentor- mentee program, 2019 (August - December) session. It briefly includes agenda of the meetings and activities conducted for the students.

Meeting: First

Date: 27.09.2019

Agenda: Introductory session

Students were briefed about the mentor-mentee program, its objectives and how they can be benefitted with it. They were advised to attend classes regularly as the PG CBCS Programme offered at the department is very intensive and requires proper guidance of the teacher. The practical papers also require significant techniques which students can learn better if they attend classes. The students were asked to set their career goals and start working on the strategies to achieve them. At the end students with short attendance for the previous month were warned about the repercussions they can face further. Personal details of each mentee were collected. (Annexure

2. Meeting: Second

Date: 20.11.2019

Agenda: Post internal exams - Lessons to learn; Preparation for UGC-NET-JRF exam Each mentee was exclusively counselled about the problems they faced in certain papers during internal exams. Probable solutions were suggested to them. Mentees were given a format to write their hobbies and career goals (Annexure 1 c). A session was conducted with the students to get an insight about their lifestyle, hobbies, tastes and specifically their academic problems. Mentees were also assisted for practical work in the paper of Geospatial technologies. Mentees preparing for the NET exam were exclusively guided.

3. Meeting: Third

Date: 23.12.2019

Agenda: Preparation for the final semester exam - The final count down

A session on preparation for final semester exams was conducted in which mentees were introduced with various strategies they can adopt to score more in the exams. The main highlights of the session include scheme of the question paper and writing strategies and time management tactics during exams.

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Mentees were also counselled on how to manage time to prepare before exams, time management to utilize maximum of their preparatory days, personal relations with family members during peak time of exams and suggested "Keep Calm Mantras" to not disturb their peace of mind. Time management strategy of "100 topics - 15 days" was discussed in detailed. They were also suggested to practice meditation for 5-10 mins. in the morning. They were also taught 'Tratak' method to improve their concentration and focus. Mentees were suggested to practice 'Pomodoro' technique using 'Productivity Efficiency' application on android platform that improves work productivity, efficient utilization of time, maintain statistical record of the working hours and breaks taken.
