Mohanlal Sukhadia University has vision and mandate “to increase access of women to education and ensuring gender justice and their empowerment”. UGC Centre for Women’s Studies, MLS University prepares Gender Action Plan for the academic session 2020-21 to guide action on embedding gender equality into organizational culture and ensuring an inclusive, gender-responsive workforce.

Women Cell (Now, UGC Centre for Women’s Studies) was established in 1988. The Centre was actively engaged in research, documentation, organising seminar, conferences, awareness drive, preparation of training modules, training government officials and extension activities. The objective of extension activities is to empower and equip women with their own skill. Later, boys and girls both joined the courses offered by the centre under its extension activities and empowered themselves financially with learnt skills and gender sensitive knowledge.

Since the academic session 2018, with the recruitment of Assistant Professor in Women’s Studies Centre, the University has started offering Academic courses in the centre.

Description: On the Occasion of 151st Birth Anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi, Center for Women's Studies, UCSSH, Mohan Lal Sukhadia University organised an event "Express Yourself".

4. National Webinar on ‘Gender & Migration’

Description: National Webinar on ‘Gender & Migration’ was organised successfully by the Centre on 27.10.2020. During Covid-19 pandemic, migration has come up with new issues & concerns and raised alarms when it comes to situation of women & children. To answer fundamental questions like what are the condition of women in a migration setting? How has the health crisis affected the exposure of female migrants to violence? And concerns related to violence against Migrant Domestic Workers in the context of COVID-19 and Beyond, Temporary Migration and family violence, Gender Based Violence etc., Gender Economist Dr. Vibhuti Patel (Retd. Professor), Tata Institute of Social Sciences enriched our students, research scholars with her depth knowledge and Ms. Jameela Begum, Founder and Lead Activists of ‘Ghar Bachao, Ghar Banao Andolan’ talked about ground reality in the capacity of Discussant of the webinar.

More than hundred participants joined the webinar from all over the country including MLSU, SNDT Mumbai, Sophia College Mumbai, D Y Patil medical College Mumbai, JNU Delhi, University of Calicut, Kerala, Lucknow University, Allahabad University, BBA Central University Lucknow, BHU Varanasi, Aligarh Muslim University & various colleges of Rajasthan among others. 82 feedback form had received within prescribed time (2 hrs after the Webinar ended). More than 60% of the participants were students and Research Scholars from the MLS University.

5. One-Week Workshop with Construction Workers with Special Focus on Adolescent Girls

Date: 26.10 to 01.11.2020

Venue: MDS Girls Hostel, MLS University

Organizer: Dr. Garima Mishra

Description: After discussion with construction workers, temporarily staying in the University Campus, it is learnt that these workers are from nearby village Banswada and they migrate from rural to urban area as per the availability of work with their families/ kin or folks. In Summer time, they are accompanied by their families and school going children. Presently, due to Covid-19 pandemic since schools are not open, all children including adolescent girls have joined their families at construction sites.

Male members, especially young boys do have android phones and they are aware of trendy things on the social media. They know Facebook, Tik-Tok, YouTube among other apps. They are aware about banking, use of ATM cards and Corona Pandemic at superficial level. Whereas, females of the community didn't have much idea about these things. Females were difficult to talk. Whereas, few adolescent girls were curious to know about career prospects after their schooling, personal hygiene, banking etc.

In view of the above and availability of families in the University Campus, One-Week Workshop with Construction Workers with special focus on Adolescent Girls is being Proposed.

Objective: Objective of the workshop is to generate awareness among the community with special focus on adolescent girls about fundamental issues like personal hygiene, awareness about Covid-19, career Prospects, basics of financial Inclusion which will help them in shaping their future.

Schedule: 5 different topics will be covered each day with respective subject experts/ Resource Persons.

It contained a Sanitary Napkin packet, one Dettol soap, 10 Masks, a Certificate and 2 awareness posters on Covid-19 in a clear bag. Students shared what they have learned in the workshop.

Introduction: In compliance of UGC D.O. NO. F 14-1/2021 (CPP-II) dated 10th May 2021, Webinar was organised by UGC Centre for Women's Studies. Webinar covered medical and psychological aspects of Covid-19. Students, research scholars, faculty members, non-teaching staff, ministerial staff and their family participated in the webinar. It was highly interactive session. Speakers entertained lot of questions from participants. Dr. Bamanian discussed medical aspects and Dr. Archana Shukla explained psychological aspects of covid-19. Dr. Garima Mishra, welcomed all the dignitaries and Director of the Centre, Prof. Pratibha Welcomed the guest and initiated the program. Dean, UCCSH Prof. Seema Malik, Associate Dean Prof. Jinendra Jain, Prof. Kalpana Jain, HOD Department of Psychology, Prof. (Retd.) Vijayalakshmi Chauhan, Prof. Digvijay Bhatnagar (HoD, Department of History), all the staff of MDS Girls Hostel were present in the webinar.

Outcome:

- Helpline was started for consultation to Covid patients in Udaipur by Department of Psychology. Department of Psychology, University of Lucknow is already providing consultation to Covid Patients in Lucknow. This worked as a role model for us.
- Awareness programme for students, faculty members, non-teaching staff, ministerial staff and their families covering two most important aspects; Medical and psychological.
- A platform was provided to teaching, non-teaching staff, students to resolve their confusion and myths regarding corona.
- Importance of Post- Covid Consultation was discussed at great length.
- Recent development in second wave corona like black fungus, corona management and covid appropriate behaviour was explained in medical terms to the participants. Importance of balance keeping in mind while recovering.
- Importance of keeping in mind while recovering because pulse rate will high be due to stress.

Prevention is always one step ahead of cure. Dean, UCSSH and Director, UGC Centre for Women's Studies, MLSU appreciated dedication of the speakers specially Dr. Bamanian for dedicating their time to connect with students and faculty members and non-teaching staff to aware about covid-19.

Introduction: UGC Centre for Women's Studies, Mohanlal Sukhadia University, on the occasion of World Menstruation Hygiene Day, organized an online Interactive Session with Dr. Piush Antony, Social Policy Specialist, UNICEF India, Ms. Laad Lohar, the Pad Woman of Udaipur and Ms. Charlotte Cotton, founding member of Mewar Collective.

Dr. Antony talked about socio- cultural and biological aspects of Menstruation focusing on existing stereotypes, taboo and stigma attached to it. Ms. Laad Lohar shared her experience of making pads in the rural area and generating awareness among girls in rural and tribal areas of Udaipur and Ms. Charlotte shared journey about Mewar collective and its work in the area.

In addition, Ms. Tanushri, Research Scholar, MLSU presented a research paper on her study on Menstrual Hygiene in Dabok, Udaipur. Ms. Tanvi, A graduate of NIFT Kolkata beautifully questioned stigma attached to menstruation through her pictorial depiction *I'mpure*.

This interactive session was attended by more than 90 participants. this helped the participants to break the silence about menstruation and provide a platform to express their thoughts in a

healthy atmosphere. Also helped participants in learning appropriate language and expressions related to menstruation.

UGC Center for Women's Studies continues its outreach program to aware and inform society by information dissemination. Some e-posters related to menstruation were shared with all the participants and University Circuits through social media like WhatsApp and Instagram page of Centre for Women's Studies, MLS University. And requested to them that the posters may be shared on social media platforms like WhatsApp to take this initiative forward.

Outcome:

1. The problem, lack of familiarity with menstrual hygiene management and its impact on reproductive health as well as overall health.
2. Recommendations for improving knowledge, attitudes, and behaviors around Menstruation.
3. Empathizing on increasing the availability of menstrual products.
4. Period-related social behaviour, how to face and improve.
