

At the outset, the Comptroller extended a hearty welcome to all the members present in the meeting. The following business/items were taken up with the permission of Chair:

01. To consider confirmation of the Minutes of the last COD held on 27.04.2017.

Resolved to confirm the minutes of the last COD meeting held on 27.04.2017 with the following modifications:

The Self finance Course at Arts College is being started from this session and the norms of the course will be at par with the other constituent colleges of the University.

Regarding implementation of CBCS Syllabus:

It was resolved that the CBCS syllabus will be implemented from current session and order will be issued under power 12(6) of the Hon-ble Vice-Chancellor and same will be got approved in the next Academic Council.

02. To consider recommendation of the committee constituted for utilization of Local Fund of the Constituent Colleges of the University:

Considered the recommendation of the committee and resolved that the fee collected in respective head from the students be spent for the purpose for which fee is collected during the Academic Year (1st July to 30th June). If there is any exigency to exceed the amount than the receipt in particular head the expenditure can be met out of previous surplus fund with the prior permission of the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor.

The saving of all the heads of the Local fund as of 30th June should be informed to the Comptroller, MLSU immediately after completion of Academic Year. The details of balance of the Local fund (including all the items) as on 31st March, 2017 should be informed to the Comptroller, MLSU. The details of FDRs created by the respective units be sent to the Comptroller at the earliest.

The surplus of Local Fund will be kept by the concerning colleges for 5 years and there after balance if any, shall be transferred to the University Development Fund.

The Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor desired that the cash-book and other accounts may be maintained properly to avoid the audit objections. The backlog has to be over with in three months.

03. To consider Office Note from V.C. Secretariat regarding follow-up of Niti Aayog:

Consider the office note and it was resolved that to develop partner state – may be Goa. Five-six activities may be identified. It was proposed to organize Educational tours of University Students, holding cultural week, sports competitions and quiz competitions. For coordinating Kashmiri Students the university has already set up a cell which will take care of grievances and issues of the Kashmiri Students. It was also decided that departments should constitute study group and undertake such research projects. The research projects that are being undertaken in the university should be based on the Tribal Areas and of relevance to government. It was decided that the research work/projects be made available on the university web site. Seminar regarding GST be also organized. The involvement of youth below 30 years in the academic activities like organizing debates and to hold Saturday Seminars across the state be organized and a panel on subjects and indentify experts who can speak on relevant issues be prepared. These persons can be hired on good remuneration. Five marks for cultural/youth events be fixed.

04. To consider establishment of Placement Cell in the university.

Consider the matter and it was resolved that as per Governor's Secretariat letter No.3801 dt.15.5.2017 a placement cell has been established in the university. The process for appointment of Placement Officer is under way.

05. To consider e-mail received from Dr.Prakash Chandra Jain regarding water recharge.

Considered the matter and it was resolved that all the wells/step-well and hand pumps in the university campus be recharged. It was also decided that Dean/Directors will check the wells and roof net-working for recharge the water level. The project of 10,000 tree plantation be taken up which shall be helpful in water recharging. The plantation programme should be completed well within this rain season only.

06. To consider the office note submitted by the Dean, PG Studies regarding revision of remuneration rates for Ministerial Staff and Peon

Considered that payment of remuneration to Ministerial Staff and Peon for the Ph.D course work and it was resolved that the previous rates of Rs.1500/- to ministerial staff and Rs.800/- to peon be revised as (1) Coordinator - Rs.5,000/-, (2) Ministerial Staff - Rs.3,000 and (3) Peon - Rs.2000/- .



At the outset, the Comptroller extended a hearty welcome to all the members present in the meeting. The following business/items were taken up with the permission of the Chair :

1. Considered confirmation of the Minutes of the COD meeting held on 28.07.2017.
 - i) While confirming the minutes, the Dean, PG studies requested to clarify the matter under item No.4(ii). After discussion in detail, it was resolved that – University should write to the UGC to clarify the issue relating to the time period meanwhile University should obtain an affidavit from the candidate stating that (i) out of the two published papers, one paper has been published in a Referred Journal and the topics of the two Research Papers are related to the topic of the thesis, (ii) the title of the two Research Papers presented is related to the topic of the thesis, and then resolved to confirm the Minutes of the meeting held on 28.07.2017.

2. To consider letter dated 10.08.2017 received from the Dy. Secretary (TE), MHRD, Deptt. of Higher Education, GOI, New Delhi regarding the Action Plan 17-by-17 to be achieved by all the Vice-Chancellors by December 2017.

The points raised in the letter have been discussed in detail and the Vice Chancellor has informed about the action taken by the University about NSDL, MOOCS, Vision Documents, Clean Campus etc. and directed all the Deans/Directors & concerned to take steps as suggested in the letter.

 - (iv) Regarding tuition fee, the Dean, College of Science will prepare a detailed note and get it approved in the next COD.
4. To consider letter No.F.1(17)(I)RB/2017/6201 dated 09.08.2017 received from the OSD(Hr.Edu.), Governor Secretariat, Jaipur regarding to send information about (i) the introduction of Ethics and Disaster Management in the syllabus, and (ii) declaration of examination results in time.

After discussion on the letter it was resolved to (i) make it a part of syllabi and the Dean, UCSSH and the Dean, UCoS will prepare course curriculum for inclusion of Ethics in the syllabus and for Disaster Management respectively and get it approved in the next COD.

Regarding declaration of results in time, it is observed by the Council that results of the University for the year 2017 were declared in time. 
It was also decided that a workshop for Deans, Directors and associate staff of the colleges will be organized by the Comptroller to provide information about the University accounting procedure.



 - (iii) Some more information may be added in QR code in comparison to the degree of 2015 ; and
 - (iv) The design and colour of the boundary may be changed with printing of University name in English in red colour.

It is further resolved that printing of degrees for the examination year 2016 may be started with above modifications and the same may be reported in the next meeting of the Academic Council.

6. The representation submitted by Mr. Gaurav Bhimawat, Research Scholar regarding the exclusion of Ph.D. scholars working as Guest Faculty from participation in students' election (only for RR) in the University was discussed and resolved that such scholars may be permitted to vote for students' election (RR Only) and necessary changes, if any, may be incorporated in the Constitution. The Dean, Students Welfare will take necessary action in this regard and inform the action taken in the next COD.
7. The Public Notice No. F.1-18/2010(CPP-II) dated 1st September, 2017 issued by the University Grants Commission regarding – "The Draft University Grants Commission (Promotion of Academic Integrity and Prevention of Plagiarism in Higher Education Institutions) Regulations, 2017" to eliminate the scope of Plagiarism menace in higher education system in the country received from Governor's Secretariat, Raj Bhawan, Jaipur vide letter No. 7094 dated 19.09.2017 has been considered and resolved to authorize the Dean, Post Graduate Studies to send suggestions to the UGC after getting approval from the Vice Chancellor as desired by the Raj Bhawan.

Note (ordinary rates) :-

(1) A Government servant who uses departmental vehicle (including staff car) for road journey from office or residence to Airport or Railway Station or Bus Stand and vice versa in connection with undertaking of a journey by air, rail or road shall not be entitled to road mileage allowance from duty point to Airport / Railway Station or Bus Stand and vice versa.

(2) Where a Government servant alights from a train / bus / aeroplane in order to catch a connecting train/ bus/ Air service, from another railway station/ bus stand/ Airport, as the case may be, at a particular place en-route his destination, he shall be entitled to road mileage allowance at the rates indicated in para (b) above of respective category.

(3) The procedure laid down in Note 3 of Remarks column of Appendix-I shall apply in respect of refund of cancellation charges on unused tickets issued by Road Transport concerned.

(4) Every Government servant who travels on duty in Air Conditioned / deluxe (including semi-deluxe) / Volvo or any upper class bus shall be required to attach the bus ticket or its photocopy in the Travelling Allowance bill.

NOTE (special rates) :-

1. Government servant shall not undertake journey by a Scooter/ Motor Cycle/ Moped etc. owned by him for a distance exceeding 25 kms. from his headquarter to places connected by rail or regular bus service.
2. Road journey by a Scooter/ Motor Cycle/ Moped etc owned by a Government servant may, however, be made for a distance not exceeding 50 kms. from his headquarters between places neither connected by rail nor by regular bus service.
3. In case journey in a Motor Car owned by a Government servant where Toll Tax is charged the journey will be valid only on production of receipt of payment of Toll Tax. The Government servant shall be entitled to toll tax charges actually paid by him in addition to the mileage allowance as admissible under the above rule.
4. In case where husband and wife both are Government servants and the motor car is owned by either of them, the journey undertaken by either in the said motor car owned by his/ her spouse would be treated to have been performed in his/ her own car for the purpose of these rules.
5. In case journey is performed in a motor car owned by a Government servant, the Mileage Allowance will be limited to the Mileage Allowance admissible upto the limit of Rail Mileage Allowance.
6. For places which are not connected by Rail, the Special rates of Mileage Allowance limited to the Rail Mileage Allowance of nearest railway station and for rest distance 'special rates' of Mileage Allowance shall be admissible.
7. Travel by own Car will be done only after prior approval of the Controlling Authority.
8. Places where short journeys are allowed such short journeys can be done by own car and for which Special rates of Mileage Allowance will be admissible.
9. For officials not entitled to travel by own vehicle, special rates of Mileage Allowance for journeys performed by own vehicle shall not be admissible.

4. Deputy Secretary, Private Secretary, Additional Private Secretary and Gunman accompanying the Chief Minister may travel by Air, if it is so desired by the Chief Minister. He shall be entitled to claim single fare of Air of the Category, which would have been admissible had he performed journey by rail or road.
5. Expenses incurred on booking Air passage are not admissible except where actual expenses for travel by Air are allowed in any case.
6. The procedure laid down in Item 3 of Remarks column of Appendix — I shall apply in respect of refund of cancellation charges of unused Air ticket.
7. If an officer undertake journey by air, no departmental vehicle should be made to follow the officer and the subordinate officers will also not perform journey to that station by Government vehicle during that period. A certificate to this effect will be recorded by the officer on his Travelling Allowance claim.

Remarks (applicable to all Categories of Government servants):

- (1) Admissibility of Daily Allowance is subject to the conditions mentioned in the schedule appended to this Appendix.
- (2) The rates for boarding and lodging charges shall be admissible only if an official stays in a Hotel/ Circuit House/ Dak Bungalow/ or any other institutions like Young-Men's Christian Association, Cricket Club of India, Youth Hostels, etc., which provide for Lodging arrangement at scheduled tariff and produces vouchers/ receipts in token of payment made on account of hotel accommodation charges. In case the actual charges paid on account of boarding and lodging are less than the ceiling prescribed in column 2 and 3 of this Appendix, actual charges paid shall only be admissible.
- (3) Where the actual hotel charges paid are inclusive of accommodation and meals and are less than the ceiling prescribed under column 2 and 3 the actual charges paid shall only be admissible.
- (4) In case accommodation is not available in Bikaner House, Rajasthan House, Jodhpur House at New Delhi, the Daily Allowance shall be admissible at rates prescribed for Delhi shown in column 2 of this appendix, subject to the conditions mentioned in point No. (2) above. The official claiming the Daily Allowance for New Delhi shall record a certificate on the Travelling Allowance claim to the effect that he actually stayed in a Hotel due to non- availability of accommodation in any of the aforesaid State Circuit Houses.
- (5) Actual taxi charges admissible under Rule 11 shall be in addition to Daily Allowance.
- (6) The provisions as contained in General Administrative (Gr.1) Department Order No. F.2(10) GA/1182 dated 20.05.1982 shall also continue to be operative so far as it relates to Government officers mentioned therein at their option, at Delhi.
- (7) These rates are inclusive of all types of taxes.

- (8) In case accommodation is not available in Bikaner House, Rajasthan House at New Delhi, officers can stay in hotel / institution, at prescribed rates after obtaining NAC from Rajasthan House, except officers of Category 'A', who can stay in hotel without obtaining NAC.
- (9) Officers of such departments, which have their Rest House (s) / Guest House(s) in Delhi can stay in hotel only after obtaining NAC from such Guest House / Rajasthan House.

- (2) In the case of Government servants who were on deputation to Public Sector Undertakings, Cooperative Societies, Autonomous Bodies etc. and who have opted for deputation allowance in terms of this department order No.F.1(47)FD(Gr.2)/82 dated 27th June, 1989, as amended from time to time and are eligible for ad-hoc bonus under this order, out of the amount of bonus paid under the Payment of Bonus Act, 1965 by the aforesaid organisation the amount equal to the amount of ad-hoc bonus admissible under this order shall be retained by the Government servants and the residual amount shall be deposited in the Government account.
- (3) Government servants on deputation who have opted for bonus and / or ex-gratia payable to the employees of the borrowing organisation in terms of this department order referred to above will be entitled to ad-hoc bonus equal to an amount by which, the bonus and / or ex-gratia admissible as per order of the borrowing organisation falls short of the total of (a) the deputation allowance which would have been admissible and (b) the ad-hoc bonus admissible under this order.
- (4) In the case of Government servants belonging to the Cooperative Department and on deputation to Cooperative Institutions registered under the Rajasthan Cooperative Societies Act, 1965 whose terms of deputation are governed by the Cooperative Department Order No. F. 18 (75) Coop. /76 dated 13.07.1976 as amended from time to time, ad-hoc bonus, equal to an amount by which the bonus/ex-gratia paid/payable as per terms of deputation falls short the total of (a) 2.5% of basic pay subject to Rs.600/- per month drawn during the year 2016-17 and (b) the amount of ad-hoc bonus admissible under this order shall be payable by such borrowing Cooperative Institution.
- (i) In cases where it is in the notice of Head of Office that the Government servant eligible for ad-hoc bonus on 31-03-2017 will definitely become ineligible for grant of ad-hoc bonus due to retrospective grant of pay in Grade Pay of Rs. 5400/- and above on promotion in State Services, only pro-rata ad-hoc bonus be permitted provided that the eligibility period is six months or more.

The payment of ad-hoc bonus, except to those Government servants who were on deputation on 31-03-2017, under these orders shall be made by the office in which an employee is posted on the date of issue of this order and it will be chargeable to the Budget Head to which the pay and allowances of the employees are charged. The payment of ad-hoc bonus to those Government servants who were sent on deputation after 31-03-2017, but before issuing of this order, shall be made by the office where the employee was posted as on 31-03-2017.

This order shall also be applicable to the employees of the Zila Parishads & Panchayat Samities and the Work-Charged employees who are drawing pay in the pay scales prescribed for them.






