#### **CONCEPT NOTE**

Libraries in educational institutes today focus on the enrichment of e-resources. The preferences for e-resources over print materials by the major user community have made these resources essential mainstay of any library collection. The huge variety of e-resources that consist of materials including journals, books, indexes, abstracts, encyclopedias, reference books, aggregator databases, and full-text or partially full-text databases are made well available to the user community by almost all the educational libraries in India. But as these resources change at a very rapid pace they need to be updated every now and then. And as library professionals are determined to build wider collections of e-resources, they have to confront challenges finding ways to manage these resources systematically including their selection, licensing, maintenance, update and some other such issues.

The core values of library science that are prompted by the five laws of Ranganathan that say : resources are for use, every person his or her resource, every resource its user, save the time of the user, and the library is a growing organism are the main driving source behind the pursuit of electronic resources by library professionals. A library can become a valuable asset to any educational institution only if it serves its basic function to fulfill the updated research requirements of its users.

Last decades of 20<sup>th</sup> century observed technological development in library electronic resources that intended to make access to resources more direct, convenient, and timely for the users. The implementation of automation and computerization, and availability of electronic resources made libraries a growing organism. But here libraries need to continuously update, facilitate and train its staff repeatedly to accommodate the advancement in the technology. The workshop is intended to unearth the search and discovery of e-resources and gives first hand practical experience of exploring the world of knowledge of e-resources for research scholars in Social Science.



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### **OBJECTIVES OF THE WORKSHOP**

The objectives of the workshop are:

- To explore research ethics for better research output.
- To develop firsthand training on searching of various e-resources.
- To expand a common understanding about electronic resources that includes e-journals, e-books, databases, datasets, standards etc.
- To create strategies for maximum utilization of e-resources.
- To identify the strategies for an effective working relationship between LIS professionals and users.
