MLSU LAW ENTRANCE TEST – MLSU-LET-2019

LL.M. ENTRANCE TEST - 2019

Admissions for LL.M. (Two Year Course) for the year 2019 on 40 (Regular) + 80 (SFS) Seats will take place through an Entrance Test (MLSU-LET-2019). Application can only be made online and process of Application will commence from **15th April, 2019**. Applications can be made through Online Process and Online Payment on the MLSU Website from **15th April, 2019 till 15th June, 2019**.

2. The result should have been declared by the date of counseling.

IV. APPLICATION PROCESS:

1. The Candidate is required to fill the Application Form for MLSU-LET-2019 on www.mlsu.ac.in and complete the registration.
2. During the registration, the candidate will be required to upload his/her photograph and signature.
3. After successful registration, the candidates are required to submit the requisite entrance fee i.e. Rs. 500/- (Five Hundred Only) for General candidates and Rs. 250/- (Two Hundred Fifty Only) for OBC/SC/ST candidates through online payment gateway.
4. No other mode of payment of fee shall be accepted.
5. After successful submission of fee, the online payment invoice will be generated.
6. There is no requirement to deposit the hard copy of the online application form before the date of counseling. However, the candidates need to keep a print-out of the online payment invoice and the complete application form as the same will be required at the time of counseling.

Note:

The candidates are advised to check and verify the application form before final submission. No Change in application form is permissible after the final submission. Incomplete forms and forms without fee payment will be rejected without any correspondence.

V. POINTS TO BE NOTED WITH RESPECT TO ENTRANCE TEST

1. Admission to the LL.M. (Two Year Course) shall be strictly on the basis of merit secured in the MLSU-LET-2019 based on the marks scored and cut-off within respective category which shall be published on the website as per the schedule.
2. The Entrance Test is scheduled to be held on **23rd June 2019 (Sunday)** from 10:00 AM to 12:00 NOON (2 Hours) reporting time 9.30 AM.
3. Examination Centers will be only in Udaipur. The information of Examination Center and Roll Number will be given on Admit Cards which will be made available on the website as per schedule.
4. The entrance test shall have 100 Objective Questions carrying one (1) mark each. There will be no negative marking.
5. The Candidate shall use only Blue/Black Ball point pen during the entrance examination.
6. After completion of entrance test, the candidates can carry Question Booklet and Carbon Copy of OMR Sheet with them.
7. No candidate will be permitted to enter the examination hall without the admit card and a valid Original photo ID card.
8. The candidates will not be allowed to enter in the Examination Hall after ten minutes of the commencement of the Examination.
9. Carrying Mobile Phone in the examination hall is strictly prohibited. If any objectionable material is found, then action will be taken under Unfair Means as per Mohanlal Sukhadia University/State Rules.

VI. ANSWER KEY AND GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL

1. The Answer Key pertaining to MLSU-LET-2019 shall be published on the University website as per the schedule.
2. Any objection with reference to Answer Key/Questions in the MLSU-LET-2019 may be submitted through mail on mlsulet@mlsu.ac.in or in writing personally delivered to the Convener, MLSU-LET- 2019, University College of Law, MLSU, Udaipur as per the schedule.
3. The grievances must include the roll number of the Candidate in the subject and any objections raised must be substantiated through the source of the objection. Grievances lacking these requirements and received beyond the scheduled time shall not be entertained.

VII. CONDITIONS FOR ADMISSION

1. The candidates need to keep a print-out of the online payment invoice and the complete application form as the same will be required at the time of counseling.
2. They need to carry following **original documents and their two photocopied and self-attested sets** at the time of Counselling-
 - (a) X, XII and all mark-sheets of U.G. Law programme
 - (b) Gap Affidavit (if applicable)
 - (c) Transfer Certificate (Not required for non-Collegiate (Private) students)
 - (d) Migration Certificate (if the last degree is from University other than MLSU)
 - (e) Caste Certificate (In case of OBC/MBC-NCL this certificate must not be older than Six (6) months from the date of admission)
 - (f) Certificate for availing the benefit of special categories (Specially Abled Person/University Wards/Ex-Serviceman/Kashmiri Migrant)
3. Fee has to be deposited at the time of final admission on the date of Counselling itself.
4. Once the student has been selected for admission and he assents to the same during admission, Affidavit in tune of Anti-Ragging policy needs to be submitted by him and his parents.
5. The students need to maintain attendance as per the BCI norms and have to compulsorily wear the uniform as prescribed by the College whilst attending the classes.

VIII. RULES AND SCHEME OF EXAMINATION:

Exam Mode: Exam will be Objective. Candidates must note that the exam will be conducted in English and Hindi Medium.

Duration: Exam will be conducted for duration of two hours (120 minutes)

Number of Questions: Candidates have to attempt a total of 100 objective type questions.

Marking Scheme: Exam will carry a total of 100 marks with each question carrying 1 mark each. Each correct answer will be given 1 mark while for incorrect answer 0 mark will be awarded with no negative marking. Candidates must note that if a question is marked with multiple answers the answer will be considered as incorrect and 0(zero) marks will be awarded for the same.
