At the outset, the Comptroller extended a hearty welcome to all the members present in the meeting. The following business/items were taken up with the permission of the Chair:

While confirming the minutes Prof. G. Soral raised about follow-up action for the formation of committees in various colleges as per Point No.11.

Studies and Convener of the Committee framing a policy for the supervisors in the Faculty of Education (item No.12 of COD meeting dated 24.01.2019) and revision of fee structure for Ph.D. programme (item No.13 of the COD meeting dated 24.01.2019) presented and submitted minutes of the meeting of the committee held on 02.07.2019, which were approved to be effective with immediate effect.
