Plagiarism which is an act of fraud involves both stealing someone else's work and lying about it afterward. Plagiarism in academic and research institutions is an old but ever growing problem. The exponential growth in scholarly publications makes it harder for faculty and instructor to detect the plagiarized sources. Plagiarism can be a very serious form of ethical misconduct. For this reason, the concept of plagiarism is universally addressed in all scholarly, artistic, and scientific disciplines.
