Polycystic Ovary Disease (PCOD) and Polycystic Ovary Syndrome (PCOS) are two words we hear quite frequently. Statistics suggest that both these lifestyle disorders are on the rise, with 1 in 8 and 1 in 5 women suffering from PCOD and PCOS, respectively in India. A recent study published in ScienceDaily suggests that women with PCOS are at a significantly increased risk of contracting COVID-19 than women without the condition. PCOS and PCOD in adolescent girls affect them not only at physical level but also at emotional and psychological levels. In view of its relevance, this interactive session is being organized to address concerns, questions, myths about the subject and to explain its symptoms, causes, effects and remedies.
