3. Distinguish between:
(a) Conciliation and Arbitration.
(b) Lockout and Layoff.
4. Define Strike, and distinguish between legal and illegal strike under the Industrial Dispute Act, 1947.
5. What are the disqualifications of office bearers of a Trade Union? Whether a person not employed in an industry may become office bearer of a Registered Trade Union? If so, what is the limit?
6. Describe the provisions regarding constitution of various funds of a Registered Trade Union under the Trade Union Act, 1926.
7. Discuss the provisions and restrictions placed under the Factories Act., 1948 relating to employment of women and children.
8. Discuss the provisions relating to payment of wages and deductions from wages under the Payment of Wages Act, 1936.

9. When and when not an employer is liable for payment of compensation under the Workmen's Compensation Act, 1923? Discuss.
10. Write in brief the composition and powers of the various authorities constituted under the Minimum Wages Act, 1948.
