1. Write a brief essay on the evolution of Indian Administration during British period. What are the legacies of British rule in India?

Examine briefly various constitutional provisions which deal with public administration.

2. Discuss the powers and functions of the Prime Minister. Assess his role in the formation of the Council of Ministers.
3. Describe the organization and functions of the Cabinet Secretariat in the Government of India. Examine the role of Cabinet Secretary as chief coordinator.
4. Explain the organization of the State Secretariat of your State. What are its functions? Explain.
5. Examine the position of District Collector in both Revenue and Development Administration.
6. Discuss the nature of relationship between Specialists and Generalists in public administration.
7. Examine the nature of parliamentary control over administration in India. Discuss various methods through which this control is exercised.

OR

What are the occasions when Judiciary is required to exercise its control over administration? What are the control mechanisms in the hands of Judiciary.

8. Examine the possibility of the establishment of the institution of Lokpal in India. Describe major attempts made by the Government in this direction.
9. Discuss the powers, functions and role of Comptroller and Auditor General of India in relation to audit of Central Government accounts in India.

10. Write short notes on any **two** of the following
- (i) Principal Features of. a Public Corporation
 - (ii) Normal Features of Budget
 - (iii) Finance Commission or Federalism and Administration
 - (iv) National Development Council
 - (v) Department of Public Entreprises in Your State
