6.3 OEM should be internationally reputed company.

8.1 For purposes of this Clause, "Force Majeure" means an event beyond the control of the Supplier

and not involving the Supplier's fault or negligence and not foreseeable. Such events may include,

but are not limited to, acts of the Purchaser either in its sovereign or contractual capacity, wars or

revolutions, fires, floods, epidemics, quarantine restrictions and freight embargoes.

8.2 If a Force Majeure situation arises, the Supplier shall promptly notify the Purchaser in writing of

such conditions and the cause thereof. Unless otherwise directed by the Purchaser in writing, the

Supplier shall continue to perform its obligations under the Contract as far as is reasonably practical,

and shall seek all reasonable alternative means for performance not prevented by the Force Majeure

event.

1. Commitments of the BUYER:
